RESOLUTION NO. 1508

RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ELECTION ON THE MATTER OF GRANTING A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO OPERATE A CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM WITHIN THE CITY OF PELLA, IOWA, AND ORDERING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF A MUNICIPAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Pella, Iowa, has enacted an ordinance granting a non-exclusive franchise to operate a cable television system within the City of Pella, Iowa, unto Pella Cablevision, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 364 of the Code of Iowa, said ordinance shall not take effect until said ordinance has been approved at an election; and

WHEREAS, an election upon said question should be held.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pella, Iowa:

Section 1: That an election, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 364 of the Code of Iowa, be and the same is hereby called for on the 10th day of July, 1979, submitting the following question to qualified electors of this municipality:

"Shall Ordinance No. 206 as set out below, granting to Pella Cablevision, Inc., a non-exclusive franchise to operate a cable television system within the City of Pella, Iowa, be approved?"

Section 2: That the County Commissioner of Elections is hereby authorized and directed to publish notice of said election in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Pella, Iowa; said publication to appear not less than four nor more than twenty days before the date set for said election as required by Section 49.53 of the Code of Iowa, 1979.

Section 3: The clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the County Commissioner of Elections as satisfaction of the thirty day "written notice" requirement of Chapter 47 of the Code of Iowa 1979.


ORDINANCE NO. 206

AN ORDINANCE TO GRANT PELLA CABLEVISION, INC., A CORPORATION ORGANIZED AND EXISTING UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF IOWA, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE NON-EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES AND AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE, MAINTAIN, REPAIR, REPLACE, RENEW, RECONSTRUCT, AND REMOVE A CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM ACROSS PUBLIC PROPERTY IN THE CITY LIMITS FOR A TERM OF FIFTEEN (15) YEARS.
