Section 50.24. CANVASS BY BOARD OF SUPER-
VISORS. The county board of supervisors shall meet
to canvass the vote at nine o'clock on the morning
of the first Monday after the day of each election to
which this chapter is applicable, unless the law au-
thorizing the election specifies another date for the
canvass. If that Monday is a public holiday, the
provisions of section four point one (4.1), subsection
twenty-two (22) of the Code shall control. Upon
convening, the board shall open and canvass the
tally lists and shall prepare abstracts stating, in
words written at length, the number of votes cast in
the county, or in that portion of the county in which
the election was held, for each office or on each
question on the ballot for the election. The abstract
shall further indicate the name of each person who
received votes for each office on the ballot, and the
number of votes each person named received for
that office, and the number of votes for and against
each question submitted to the voters at the election.

The County Board of Supervisors shall canvass the
returns for School Districts on the next Friday after
the School Election. (See Section 277.20.)

An ordinance granting unto Midwest Power, a division of Midwest Power Systems, Inc., its successors and assigns, the right, franchise and privilege for a period of twenty-five (25) years from and after the adoption and approval hereof, to acquire, construct, operate and maintain in the city of Harvey, Iowa, the necessary facilities for the production, distribution, transmission and sale of electric energy for public and private use; to use and occupy the public streets, highways, avenues, alleys, bridges and public places for such purposes; and prescribing the terms and conditions thereof; and granting unto said company the right of eminent domain, the exercise of which is subject to city council approval.

Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Harvey, Iowa:

Section 1. That Midwest Power, a division of Midwest Power Systems Inc., a corporation, its successors and assigns, be and it is hereby granted and vested with the right,

franchise and privilege for a period of twenty-five (25) years from and after the adoption and approval hereof, as provided by law, to acquire, construct, operate and maintain in the City of Harvey, Iowa, the necessary facilities for the production, distribution, transmission and sale of electric energy for public and private use and to construct and maintain along, upon, across and under the streets, highways, avenues, alleys, bridges and public places the necessary fixtures and equipment for such purposes; and for the term of this franchise the Company is further granted the right of eminent domain, the exercise of which is subject to City Council approval upon application by the Company.

Section 2. This franchise shall not be exclusive and shall not restrict in any manner the right of the City Council or any other governing body of the City in the exercise of any regulatory power which it may now have, or hereafter be authorized or permitted, by the laws of the State of Iowa.
