## PUBLIC MEASURE A

### SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

A local sales and services tax shall be imposed in the unincorporated areas of the County of Marion, Iowa, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from January 01, 2004 until December 31, 2013.

Revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:

**Fifty percent (50%) for property tax relief.**

The specific purposes for which the revenue shall otherwise be expended are: **Fifty percent (50%) for community betterment, including, but not limited to payment for debt, construction costs, capitalized repair funds, and any other costs associated with the following projects: 1.) The historic preservation of the Marion County Courthouse. 2.) Capital equipment, Improvement projects, construction, and repair. 3.) The improvement of Marion County Secondary Road Projects.**

A local sales and services tax shall be imposed in the City of Knoxville, Iowa, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from January 01, 2004 until December 31, 2013.

Revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:

Zero percent (0%) for property tax relief.

The specific purposes for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended are: One hundred percent (100%) of said local option sales and services tax to be allocated for the following public purposes, to-wit: maintenance and repair of infrastructure in the City of Knoxville, Iowa, to include streets, sidewalks, stormwater control, sanitary sewers, bridges, and the purchase of capital equipment.




