

SAMPLE

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Shall the Board of Directors of the Knoxville Community School District in the County of Marion, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years to continue to levy and impose an instructional support tax in an amount (after taking into consideration instructional support state aid) of not exceeding seven percent of the total of regular program district cost for the budget year and moneys received under Iowa Code Section 257.14 as a budget adjustment in the budget year, and be authorized annually, in combination, as determined by the Board, to levy an instructional support property tax upon all the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy of property taxes for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, and to impose an instructional support income surtax upon the state individual income tax of each individual income taxpayer resident in the School District on December 31 for each calendar year commencing with calendar year 2007, or each year thereafter, the percent of income surtax to be determined by the Board for each fiscal year, to be used for purchasing textbooks and other learning supplies and materials, technology equipment and software, library books and materials, music equipment and supplies and professional staff development?
