SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Shall the Board of Directors of the Pella Community School District in the Counties of Marion, Mahaska, and Jasper, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$12,905,000 to provide funds to build, furnish and equip a new elementary school building; to build furnish and equip an addition to and to improve, remodel, repair, furnish and equip existing school facilities and sites, it being the intention of the School District to apply a portion of the receipts of the Marion County local sales and services tax for school infrastructure purposes to abate and reduce the levy of taxes to pay principal and interest on the Bonds?

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Shall the Board of Directors of the Pella Community School District in the Counties of Marion, Mahaska, and Jasper, State of Iowa, be authorized to levy annually a tax exceeding three dollars and twenty five cents per thousand dollars, but not exceeding three dollars and sixty cents per thousand dollars of assessed value of the taxable property within said school corporation to pay the principal of and interest on bonded indebtedness of said school corporation, approval of this proposition shall not limit the source of payment of the bonds and interest, but shall only operate to restrict the amount of bonds which may be issued?
