SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEASURE NO. 1

"Shall the Pleasantville Community School District, in the Counties of Marion and Warren, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue general obligation bonds in an amount of not to exceed \$1,895,000.00, to provide funds to defray the cost of building and furnishing a new elementary school building?"

SHALL THE ABOVE PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEASURE NO. 2

"Shall the Board of Directors of the Pleasantville Community School District, in the Counties of Marion and Warren, State of Iowa, be authorized to levy annually a tax exceeding two dollars and seventy cents per thousand dollars, but not exceeding four dollars and five cents per thousand dollars on the assessed value of the taxable property within said school corporation to pay the principal of and interest on bonded indebtedness of said school corporation, it being understood that the approval of this proposition shall not limit the source of payment of the bonds and interest, but shall only operate to restrict the amount of bonds which may be issued?"

SHALL THE ABOVE PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

SUMMARY OF PUBLIC MEASURE NO. 3

"Shall the Board of Directors of the Pleasantville Community School District, in the Counties of Marion and Warren, State of Iowa, be authorized to sell and dispose of school property, both the site and improvements thereon, said site being legally described as Lot 8, Block 2, J.R.R. Addition and S. 8' of W. 78.2' of Vac. Alley E. & W. N. of Lot 8, Pleasantville, Iowa, (and locally known as 306 N. Polk, Pleasantville, Iowa), and to place the proceeds derived from said action into the Schoolhouse Fund for use in connection with the building and furnishing of a new elementary school building?"
