Section 50.24. CANVASS BY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS. The county board of supervisors shall meet to canvass the vote at nine o'clock on the morning of the first Monday after the day of each election to which this chapter is applicable, unless the law authorizing the election specifies another date for the canvass. If that Monday is a public holiday, section 4.1, subsection 22 controls. Upon convening, the board shall open and canvass the tally lists and shall prepare abstracts stating, in words written or length, the number of votes cast in the county, or in that portion of the county in which the election was held, for each office and on each question on the ballot for the election. The board shall contact the chairperson of the special precinct board before adjourning and include in the canvass any absentee ballots which were received after the polls closed in accordance with section 53.17 and which were canvassed by the special precinct board after election day. The abstract shall further indicate the name of each person who received votes for each office on the ballot, and the number of votes each person named received for that office, and the number of votes for and against each question submitted to the voters at the election.
Any obvious clerical errors in the tally lists from the precincts shall be corrected by the supervisors. Complete records of any changes shall be recorded in the minutes of the canvass.

"SHALL THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE TWIN CEDARS COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTIES OF MARION AND MAHASKA, STATE OF IOWA, BE AUTHORIZED TO RAISE ANNUALLY, FOR A PERIOD OF SEVEN YEARS, AS DETERMINED BY THE BOARD, ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR AN INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT PROGRAM FOR THE DISTRICT, WITH SUCH ADDITIONAL FUNDING NOT TO EXCEED TEN PERCENT OF THE TOTAL REGULAR PROGRAM DISTRICT COST FOR THE BUDGET YEAR AND MONIES RECEIVED UNDER SECTION 257.14 AS A BUDGET ADJUSTMENT FOR THE BUDGET YEAR; THE ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO BE RAISED BY A COMBINATION OF STATE AID AND OF INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT PROPERTY TAX LEVIED ANNUALLY UPON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY IN THE DISTRICT, COMMENCING WITH THE LEVY FOR COLLECTION IN THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1995, AND OF AN INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT INCOME SURTAX IMPOSED ANNUALLY (THE PERCENT OF INCOME SURTAX NOT TO EXCEED SEVEN PERCENT), TO BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD FOR EACH BUDGET YEAR, TO BE IMPOSED UPON THE STATE INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX OF EACH INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAXPAYER RESIDENT IN THE DISTRICT ON DECEMBER 31, 1995, AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, TO BE USED FOR THE GENERAL FUND PURPOSES OF PURCHASING TECHNOLOGICAL EQUIPMENT FOR INSTRUCTIONAL PURPOSES, INCLUDING SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS FOR THIS EQUIPMENT, AND TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, AND SUPPLIES TO ENHANCE THE CURRICULUM?"
