

Marion County Entrance Permit (Top)

This permit allows applicant to construct an entrance with a concrete, asphalt, or seal coat type top. Marion County will not be responsible for the maintenance of any hard surfaced entrance top.

All entrances (except the hard surface top) and the associated culvert pipe located on Marion County right-of-way shall become the property of Marion County at the time of acceptance.

Marion County will not be responsible for damage or reconstruction of entrance top in the event that we need to perform maintenance within our right-of-way.

- C. Minimum thickness of concrete on Marion County R.O.W. shall be 6 inches and no reinforcing bar or wire shall be placed directly over a drainage structure.
