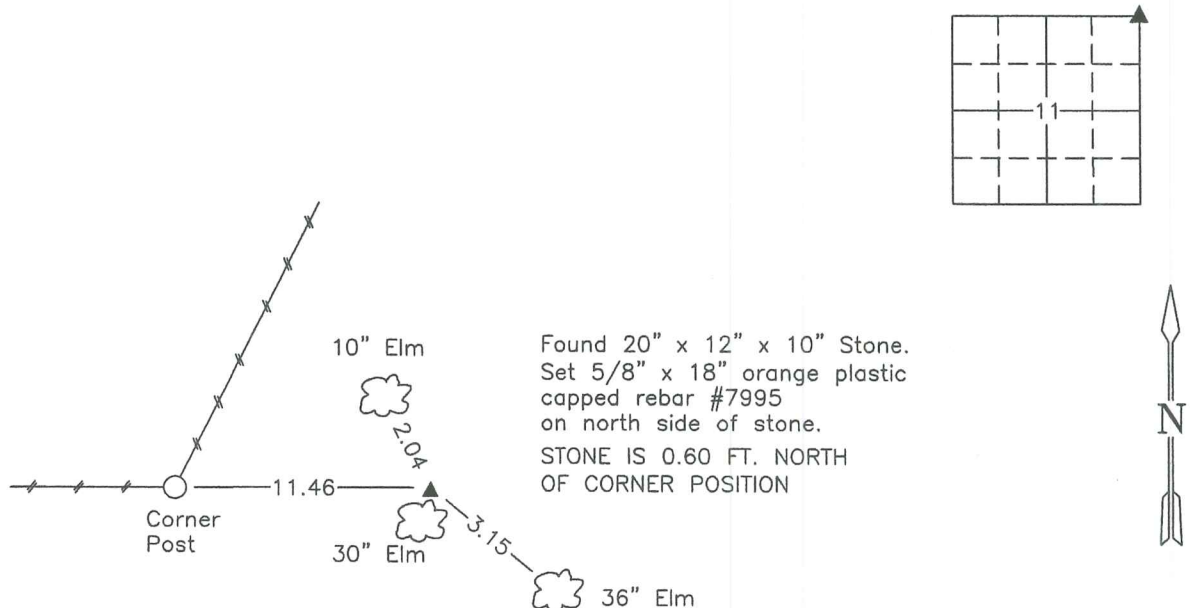

Monument Description and Remarks: Found 20" x 12' x 10" stone partially under and on N. side of tree.  
This stone believed to be the N. stone referred to in 12/15/1939 WPA notes and ties. WPA concrete monument  
believed to be under tree or obliterated. Set 5/8" x 18" orange plastic capped rebar, #7995, on  
north side of stone. Stone is 0.60 feet north of corner based on N-S and E-W fence intersection.  
This corner was used to establish the E. 1/4 Corner of Sec. 11 for a Plat of Survey for Parcel A in the SE 1/4  
of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 11.

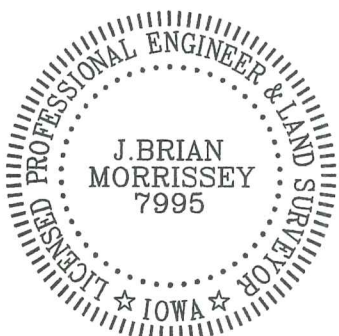
