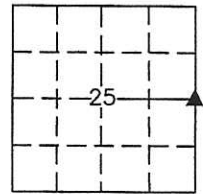

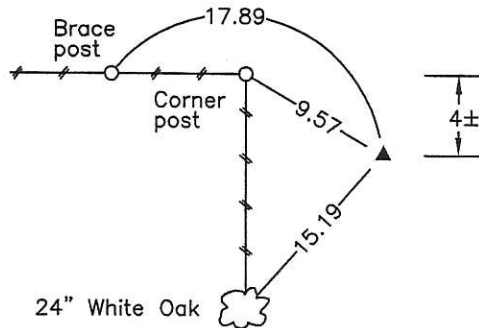
This Corner was used for a Plat of Survey in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 25, recorded in Bk. 2015, P. 2713.
