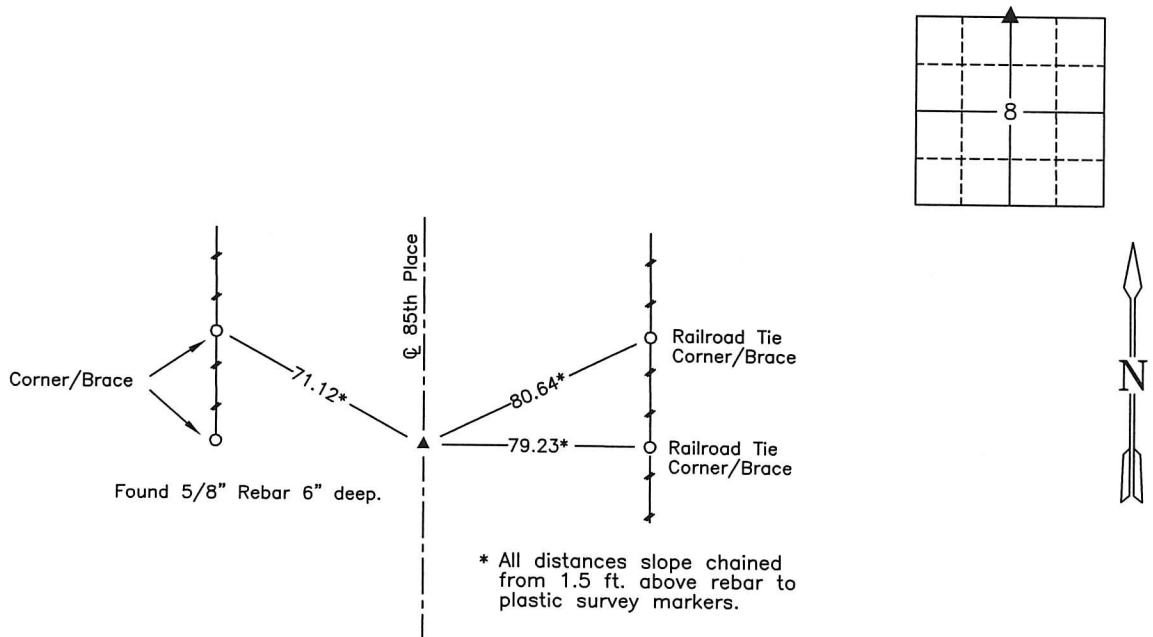

Monument Description and Remarks: Found 5/8" rebar 6" deep. Monument believed to have been set after C.O.E. grading of 85th Place in early 1970's, road fill of 10'-12' over original WPA concrete monument. Verified E-W position by distance to west to approximate NW Cor. of Sec. 8 (probed and hit what believed to be concrete monument 2.5' deep at 4 way fence intersection as per Co. Engr. Office field book 1, page 52). Distance to NE Cor. of Sec. 8 by Co. Engr. Office field book 1, page 39 comparable to measured distance to approximate NW Cor.. This corner was used for a Plat of Survey for Parcel A in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 8.

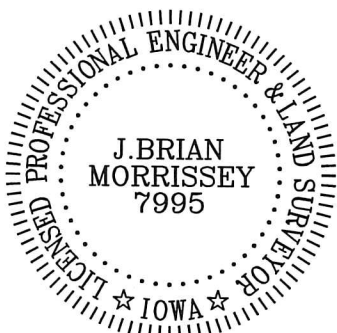

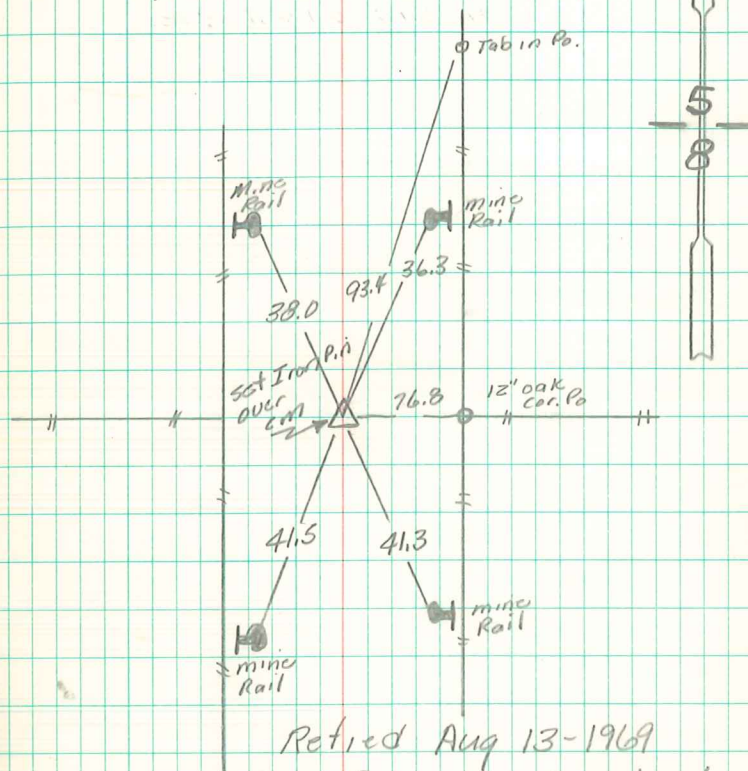
